



WHAT IS THE QUALITYMARK PROGRAM?



Independent | Certified | LTTR +

The QualityMark Program is a voluntary program Hunter Panels participates in. The program is operated by PIMA. PIMA and Intertek, as the program administrator, maintain the program requirements and publish a report of the participating manufacturing locations that conform to the requirements. The program tests and certifies long-term thermal resistance values and R-values from randomly selected distributor locations.

WHAT HUNTER PANELS INSULATION PRODUCTS ARE COVERED UNDER THE QUALITYMARK PROGRAM?

Hunter Panels products covered by the QualityMark Program are classified as meeting the requirements of ASTM C1289, Type I-VI, except for Type II, Class 4

Products Include:

- H-Shield
- H-Shield CG
- Tapered H-Shield
- Tapered H-Shield CG
- H-Shield HD Composite CG
- Tapered Sumps, Hips and Valleys
- H-Shield NB
- Cool-Vent

WHAT CRITERIA DETERMINE WHICH MANUFACTURING LOCATIONS ARE LISTED IN THE QUALITYMARK PROGRAM QUARTERLY CONFORMANCE REPORT?

A manufacturing location must be operated by a participating manufacturer and maintain a current LTTR-value certification to be listed in the conformance report. Additionally, the tested samples for R-value verification (distribution samples) for each participating manufacturing location must result in a measured R-value at 180-days that is equal to or greater than the published LTTR-value for the product at the same labeled thickness. A manufacturing location operated by a participating manufacturer that is not listed in the conformance report has failed to meet one or more of the program's compliance requirements.
